All students pursuing teacher certification must apply and be accepted to the [Office of Educator Preparation](#).
'C' or better in: • 010 Core •020 Core •040 Core •two 060/070 Core courses (2 of 4 must be 'C' or better)
'B' or better in 090 Core COMM/SPCH; if 'C' is earned student may not have to repeat but will have to complete additional steps at TXST.

Any student admitted to Texas State may declare and be admitted to the instructional aide pathway education program under a temporary status known as "pre-major." Once you have accumulated at least 36 credit hours and meet the requirements outlined below, you will be admitted to the school in full-major status. You will not be admitted to the major if you fail to meet these requirements.

- Minimum of one year employment as an instructional aide, and current employment as an instructional aide in a Texas PK-12 public or accredited private school district
- Minimum 2.25 overall GPA
- Completed pre-major: 36-37 credit hours

Repeating Courses: A course taken for transfer credit must be repeated as transfer credit to count as a repeat. When a course is taken more than once from a transfer institution, the second grade (first repeat) and all subsequent grades (repeats) are included in computing the Overall hours attempted, grade points earned and GPA.
